Opt-Out Of 48 Hour Working Week Agreement

The Working Time regulations 1998 provide that the Temporary Worker shall not work in excess of the Working Week unless he agrees in writing that this limit should not apply.

For clarification the "Working Week" means an average of 48 hours each week calculated over a 17 week reference period.

- The Temporary Worker hereby agrees that the working week limit shall not apply.
- The Temporary Worker may end this Agreement by giving not less than three months' notice in writing.
- For the avoidance of doubt, any notice bringing this Agreement to an end shall not be construed as notice of termination by the Temporary Worker.
- Upon the expiry of the notice period set out in clause 1 the Working Week limit shall apply with immediate effect.
- These Terms are governed by the law of England & Wales and are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England & Wales.
